Sol.Tavani: How would that cloud your ability to make a fair determination of the candidate?

Comm. Ruth: Make another motion.

Sol. Tavani: It's your right to abstain, no one on this Board can force you to vote, but you do have a 2-2 tie.

Comm. Hans: Is it really 2-2? Abstain doesn't count as a vote?

Cl.Crockett: The vote was - Hans yes, McManus no, Weindel yes, Ruth no and Paul abstained.

Sol.Tavani: I thinks it's legally permissible because you have the majority of those able to vote voting, and the abstention would act to knock the Board down to a 4 membership. So 2 would be a majority, so he's approved.

Cl.Crockett: What's this now?

Comm. Hans: An abstain doesn't count as a no?

Cl.Crockett: It's 2-2. Hans yes, McManus no, Weindel yes, Ruth no and Paul abstained.

Comm. Hans: Oh never mind. I thought there was only one no. That's correct, my bad, sorry Mr. Chair.

Sol.Tavani: I misunderstood, I thought it was 2-1.

New Business, continued

Comm. Ruth: That's OK. Now where do we go with this Rich? You have basically the final vote.

Sol. Tavani: You don't have to abstain.

Comm. Paul: Do we make a second motion to have a vote again?

Comm. Ruth: Make the motion.

Motion made by Comm. Paul, seconded by Comm. Hans to have a second vote on Steve Zimmerman as a member. All in favor, ayes have it. Roll call vote, Comms. Hans, Paul, and Weindel yes, Comms. McManus and Ruth, no.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Candidates can pick up an application at either fire house or the Fire
 Administration Building (FAB), or contact the Department via e-mail at
 <u>join@lindenwoldfire.com</u>
 They should be instructed to return their completed application to the FAB.
- Candidate submits application at the FAB including birth certificate, driver's license and social security card.
- Applicant's general information is submitted to the Membership Commissioner and the Fire Administrator via e-mail for them to contact the candidate ASAP.
- Background check and drivers abstract are submitted.
- Candidate application packet with background check and drivers abstract are submitted to Membership Commissioner and Fire Administrator for the interview.
- The interview will be conducted by the Membership Commissioner, Fire Adminstrator or Deputy Chief. If candidate is accepted, the interviewer will provide the candidate with instructions and authorization to get their physical.
 *(no gear or equipment is to be issued until the candidate has completed their physical and insurance beneficiary forms)
- Candidate returns the relief association form to FAB for notarization and have their insurance beneficiary forms filled out.
- Candidate is asked to attend the next regular Board of Fire Commissioners meeting for introduction and swearing in.
